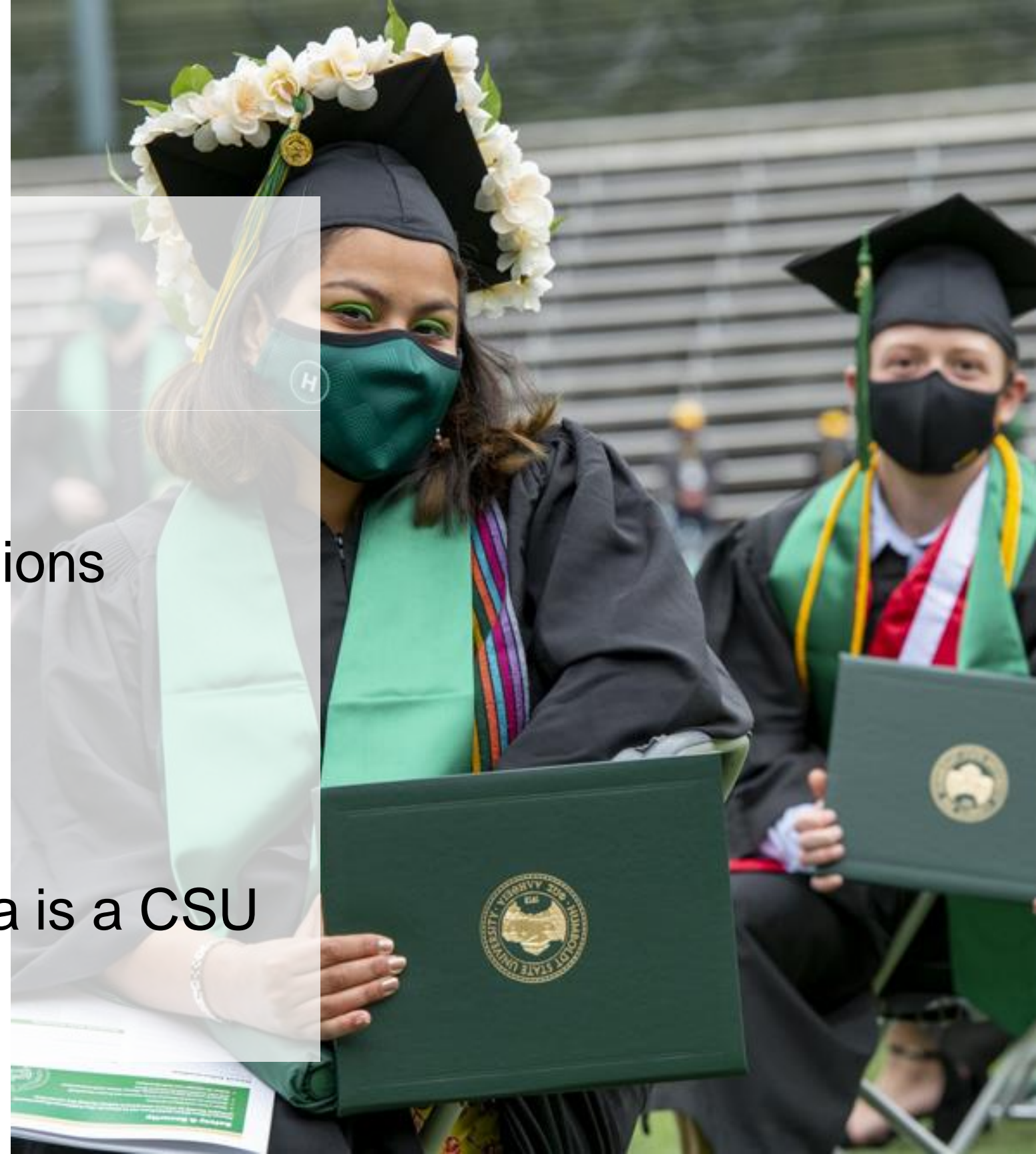
- Spring Graduations

- Budget





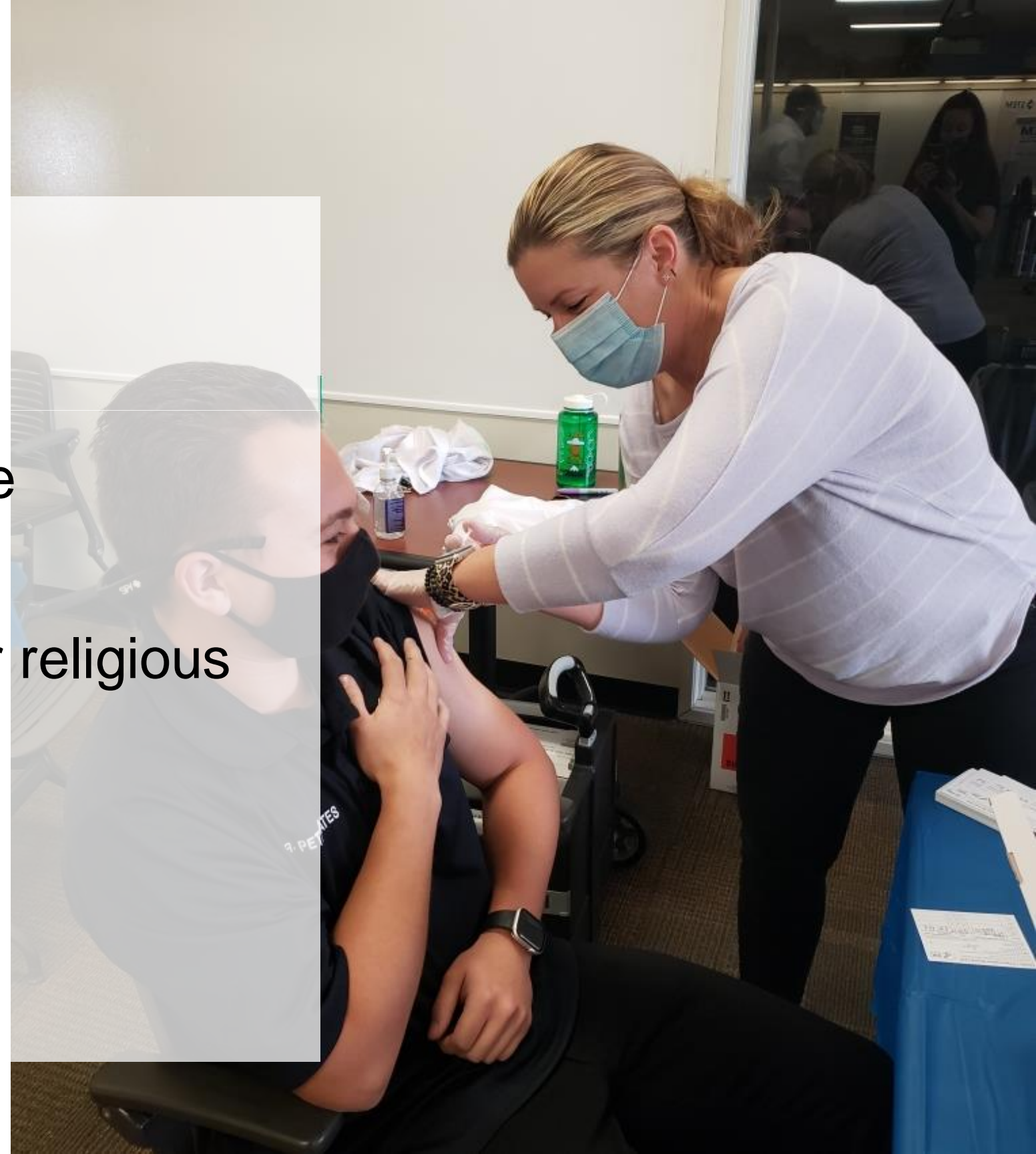
# Graduation

- 130,000 degrees awarded
  - More than 90% health professions students graduated on-time
- The class of 4 million
  - 84% remained in California
  - 1 in 10 employees in California is a CSU graduate



# Vaccination Requirement

- All students and employees to be immunized for SAR-CoV-2
- Exemptions based on medical or religious grounds





# State Budget

- \$1.4 billion investment
  - \$596.1 million ongoing funds
  - \$833 million onetime funds
- \$299 million budget restoration
- \$185.9 million general funds





# State Budget

- \$6 Million for Bakersfield Campus Nursing and Health Professional programming
- \$1.8 Million for Physician Assistant Program for San Bernardino Campus
- \$2.5 Million for the Humboldt State nursing program

- Public Health Research Fellowship
- CCC-CSU Nursing Collaborative
- Health Professions Concurrent Enrollment Program Expansion



# Public Health Fellowships

- System-wide partnership with UCOP
- Research fellowships for undergraduate students
- Pipeline development with doctoral granting institutions





# CCC-CSU Nursing Collaborative

- Inaugural CCC-CSU Nursing Directors Collaborative in March
- Purpose: to develop and support partnerships between the two public education systems in an effort to improve nursing education.



# Concurrent Enrollment Program Expansion

- Concurrent admissions
- Streamlined curriculum
- Coordinated financial aid





# Upcoming Initiatives

- Pre-Doc Health Professions Track
- Health Professions Advising Alignment
- Apprenticeships





# Pre-Doc Health Professions Track

- Create seamless transition to health professions doctoral programs
- Provides mentorship from faculty members at doctoral health professions institutions
- Provides funds for travel and other supportive activities (academic enrichment activities, admissions test, admissions fees)





# Health Professions Advising

- Centralized alignment of advising
- Student wraparound services
- Course sequencing
- Community College transfers



# Apprenticeship

- Newly formed collaboration between Department of Labor and Department of Apprenticeship Standards
- Addressing needs to high-skilled apprenticeships
- Establishing Clinical Laboratory Scientist (San Jose) and Cybersecurity (San Bernardino) apprenticeships
