The California Medicine Scholars Program (CMSP) is a statewide, structured pathway to produce more underrepresented minority physicians and reduce health disparities in our California communities.

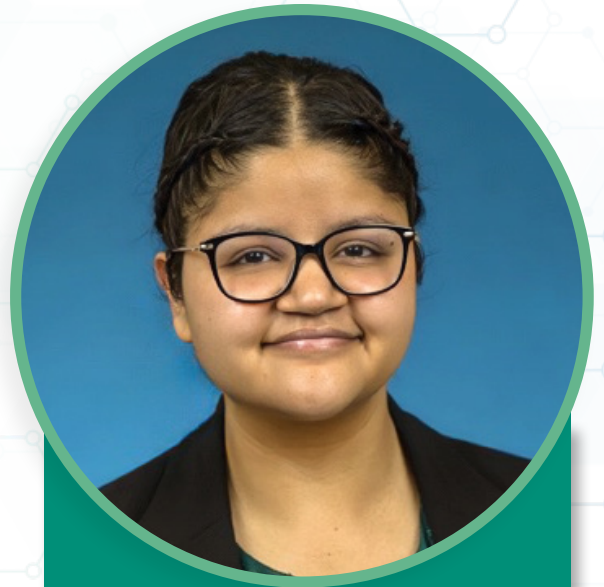
