## Experienced Pipeline Update

Meetings: March 18 and April 29, 2021

- Pipeline programs are funded in various ways:
  - Philanthropy (Foundation grants)
  - Contracts with school districts
  - State funding
  - Federal funding
  - Private Grants/Donations
  - University/Hospital "Community Benefit" funds
  - · Crowd funding.
- Covid pandemic led to opportunities and challenges for member programs and students
  - Pivoting to online education/programming
  - Loss of in-person shadowing or internship opportunities; developing virtual options (e.g., FACES provided mock telehealth visits involving pediatric consultations and role playing)
  - Helping students deal with loss and mental health needs/wellbeing
  - Sharing various mental health resources with students on campus, online & in community

- Three health pathway focused legislative bills: AB 1306 (Assemblymember Arambula), SB 395 Senator Caballero), SB 40 (Senator Hurtado)
- OSHPD is developing a new statewide council to replace the Song Brown Commission and focus more broadly on primary care health workforce needs
- Funding Updates: Seek support from University Alumni Associations (Chicano/ Latino and African American)
- Creating a pipeline funding letter to highlight selfagency and power building focused on serving underserved youth as a means of workforce development.
- Statewide student mental health conference
- Statewide speaker series for all health pathway programs


