

Dr. Evita Limon-Rocha is a Latina Spanish speaking dually board-certified Child, Adolescent, and Adult psychiatrist. She received her bachelor's degree from the University of California, Riverside, her master's degree in Public Health from the University of California, Los Angeles and her medical degree from the David Geffen School of Medicine at the University of California, Los Angeles. She is board member of a nonprofit Reach Out, is a board member for the Chicano Latino Alumni Association at UC Riverside, along with other roles in national organizations such as National Hispanic Medical Association.

Dr. Evita Limon-Rocha has found great meaning working with non-profits, including working toward strengthening and creating pipeline programs to increase diversity within higher education, the sciences, medicine, and ultimately psychiatry. She hopes to continue to serve as a mentor to students of all levels. She remains committed to work to assuring families, especially monolingual Spanish families, will not experience the substandard medical care she has witnessed so many times. This work fuels her spirit. This work gives her meaning. Her ultimate goal is to decrease stigma around the utilization of mental health services and mental health diagnoses, specifically within underserved communities and the Latino community.
