Family Nurse Practitioner

o Announce awards by end of October.

- Included \$1 million to support certified nurse midwife and licensed midwife training programs.
- Next application cycle will include funding to support FNP and Physician Assistant fellowship programs.

Primary Care Residency

o Announce awards by end of November.



Education Capacity Expansion Programs (2/5)

Social Work Education Capacity Expansion Grant Program

- Building and expanding Bachelor of Art in Social Work and/or Master of Social Work(MSW) programs
- Open Now

Psychiatric Education Capacity Expansion

- Supports programs building or expanding psychiatry residency, child/adolescent psychology fellowships, addiction psychiatry, and psychiatric mental health nurse practitioner training programs.
- Announce awards Fall 2022.



Education Capacity Expansion Programs (3/5)

- Train New Trainer (TNT) Primary Care Psychiatry Fellowship
 Scholarship
 - Year-long program for primary care providers to receive advanced training in primary care psychiatry.
- Train New Trainers (TNT) Primary Care -Training and Education in Addiction Medicine
 - Year-long program for primary care providers to receive training on the most frequently encountered pain and addiction-related disorders and treatments.



Education Capacity Expansion Programs (4/5)

Peer Personnel Training and Placement Program

- Builds the peer personnel specialist workforce
- Recruits, trains, certifies, and places peer personnel to serve in public behavioral health and community-based settings

Behavioral Health Coach

- New provider category as part of the Children and Youth Behavioral Health Initiative
- Goal: begin training future BH Coaches in 2024.



Education Capacity Expansion Programs (5/5)

Certified Nursing Assistant/Home and Community Based Services

- Request For Information open now, through October 7.
- Project goal: increase the clinical workforce of Certified Nursing Assistants (CNs), Home Health Aides (HHAs), Licensed Vocational Nurses (LVNs), and Registered Nurses (RNs) throughout California

Health Professions Careers Opportunity Program (1/2)

Health Professions Pathways Program

- Provides funding to organizations to recruit and support students from underrepresented regions and backgrounds. Program components can include:
 - pipeline programs
 - internships
 - post undergraduate fellowships
- Awarded \$40.8 million to 20 organizations, supporting 32,800 participants in 30 counties.

Health Professions Career Opportunity Program (2/2)

Health Careers Exploration Program

- Provides funding to organizations to strengthen educational and social foundations by providing direct and indirect program support for underrepresented and/or disadvantaged individuals interested in pursuing healthcare careers.
- Awards up to \$25,000 to institutions to support conferences, workshops, or career exploration activities.
- In April 2022, awarded \$600,000 to 34 organizations.

Health Workforce Education and Training Council

- 18-member public body
- Develop statewide graduate medical education (GME) and workforce training priorities.
- Advocate for additional funds and additional sources of funds to stimulate GME expansion in California.
- Provide technical assistance and support for establishing new GME and training programs in California.
- Increase workforce diversity and improve access to care for underserved and Medi-Cal populations.
- Focus on primary care, behavioral health, oral health, and allied health.
